Tired of Wendy's constant bullying, the group decide to take action and show Wendy the true joys of being a flesh eating corpse.

Aspiring young filmmakers have been attending workshops at Skelmersdale Library, working on all aspects of filmmaking from script to screen, set-design to prosthetic make-up and all in-between. Award winning filmmaker James Shaw has been facilitating the workshops to help the group bring their vision to life (or death!).
