About the Arts Award map

Preston Creative Exchange is Preston's Local Cultural Education Partnership (LCEP) made up of a group of people working together to ensure that all children & young people have access to arts and culture in Preston. They are exploring ways in which they can create a joined-up approach to Arts Award advocacy and delivery across Preston.

5 organisations within the LCEP have been working with an Arts Award mentor to map their existing offer for children and young people to the 5 levels of Arts Award in order to create a clear and concise Arts Award Supporter offer.

Blaze are now seeking to commission an early career designer, to bring together these individual Arts Award Supporter offers into an eye catching and user-friendly piece of design. The designer will be fully supported throughout this process to bring these ideas together into a practical and engaging document.

Purpose:

For the LCEP this resource will be an opportunity to highlight the collective offer for Arts Award across Preston.

For Advisers and those young people completing the higher levels of Arts Award it will provide information as where to access Arts Award activity.

This resource is aimed at Arts Award Advisers who are looking for appropriate Arts Award activity for the young people they are working with. It will also be useful for young people aged 16-25 who are independently working towards their Arts Award.

- The illustrated map needs to be a visual representation of Preston, the Arts Award Supporters and the LCEP
- The detailed information needs to be a straightforward layout, well-spaced, easy to read and digest and include echoes of the illustrated map.
- Consistent design throughout the resource
- Professional and modern
- High quality images, symbols and illustrations.

You must be registered as self employed and responsible for paying your own National Insurance and Tax contributions. We are looking for someone with experience in illustration, designing for web and creating interactive PDF documents with clickable links. We particularly welcome applications from those often marginalised from the arts, including people under the age of 30, working class people, disabled people, LGBTQIA+ people, people of South, East and South East Asian heritage, People of African or Caribbean heritage, Irish Traveller heritage and Latinx heritage.

How to apply:

Please send a short cover letter with a maximum of 5 examples of relevant design/illustration work with a bit of a description. Please add links to your website or Instagram etc if you think that's helpful.

Please include:

- A bit about yourself and previous experiences of working on similar projects
- Your approach to this piece of design
- Breakdown of your time on the project
